

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

Step 1: Print page 5 of this printable (look for the print logo)



- Step 2: Have your child decorate the various parts of the card get creative with crayons, colored pencils, paint, glitter etc.
- Step 3: Cut and/or supervise your child cut the decorated shapes
- Step 4: Take a separate piece of paper to create the base of your card. Fold it in half to form the card. You can use colored construction paper, cardstock or plain computer paper for this step.
- Step 5: Design your card by gluing the cut & decorated parts from below to your folded paper.
